Commonwealth Care Quality Health Insurance at Low or No Cost

You may be eligible for Commonwealth Care if you meet certain requirements. If you are uninsured and can't get insurance through your job or your family and you earn less than \$30,636 a year individually (or \$61,956 for a family of four) you may qualify for a low or no cost plan.

What to Bring

- A passport, *or* a birth certificate with a driver's license, *or* proof of legal residency.
- Two recent pay stubs or your latest taxes.

Who Should Come

- Uninsured individuals and families, **ages 18–64**

Act NOW: Penalties accumulate monthly in 2008, adding up to as much as \$912 for the year. Learn about your options.
